SPEAKER MARVEL: Senator Wesely, for what purpose do you rise?

SENATOR WESELY: I just wanted to follow up on Senator Fowler's comments. All I wanted to say was as a member of the Public Health and Welfare Committee, and given that one year grace period which as Senator Fowler has astutely found out, I think that we ought to take the time to look at this. I think that we have a situation here in the sunset review process where we can really take a look at some of these different areas and I think we ought to do it. We didn't I think take as careful a look as we might of on this specific one, that is, funeral homes and the funeral home industry, and Senator Chambers has brought some very good amendments that we ought to take a look at. So I think I would be willing as a member of the committee to take the time to spend to have a hearing and to look at the matter.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The only vote that can be taken this morning is the vote that we are about ready to take because the time allotted is up. Senator Chambers, I will go ahead and put the question. Is the question put properly, sections 24 through 39 which have to do with definitions? 23 through 39? Okay. Do you have the motion down? We are voting on the definition section of the Chambers amendments to LB 94. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote no. Have you all voted? Have you all voted? One more time, then the Chair is going to call for the vote. Have you all voted? How many excused? Six are excused.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Mr. Chairman, I am going to ask for a Call of the House and a roll call voted.

SPEAKER MARVEL: A Call of the House has been requested. The Clerk will clear the Board. All legislators take their seats and record your presence. All unauthorized personnel please leave the floor. I am sorry. I moved too fast. We are now voting on a Call of the House. Clerk, record the vote.

CLERK: 17 ayes, 0 nays to go under Call, Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The House is now under Call. All legislators should be in their seats. Record your presence. Unauthorized personnel, please leave the floor.
