SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion is on the adoption of Senator Maresh's amendment. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote no. This is the emergency clause. Have you all voted? We're voting on the emergency clause to the bill 268. Have you all voted? The motion is on the adoption of the emergency clause. Record.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Okay, now Senator Newell, do you move the advancement of the bill?

SENATOR NEWELL: Yes.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion is the advancement of 268 as amended. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote no. The next bill we'll take up is LB 342, as soon as we get 25 votes on this one. Record.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Okay. Senator George...oh, I'm sorry, Mr. Clerk. 342.

CLERK: Mr. President, LB 342 was a bill introduced by Senator Walter George of the 16th. (Read by title LB 342.) The bill was first read on January 16. It was referred to the Ag and Environment Committee. It was advanced to General File. There are Committee amendments, Mr. President.

SENATOR GEORGE: Mr. President, I move the adoption of the Committee amendments. Since Senator Schmit is not here, I can just briefly explain it. The Committee wanted to add a specific fee for motor vehicle inspection, not to exceed \$5.00, and the Committee reduced a \$5,000.00 fine down to \$100.00. These are the two basic Committee amendments that came in through the Ag Committee.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion is the adoption of the Committee amendments to 342. Senator Wesely, do you wish to be recognized?

SENATOR WESELY: Yes, I have some questions for Senator George.

SENATOR GEORGE: Yes sir.
