CLERK: Senator Cope voting aye; Senator Landis voting aye, Senator Landis had voted aye, excuse me; Senator Hoagland voting aye; Senator Burrows voting aye.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Okay, Clerk, record the vote.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 9 nays to cease debate, Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The debate is ceased. Senator Newell, you have time to move the bill and that is all. Do you wish to advance the bill? The motion is to advance 345 to E & R for review. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote no. Have you all voted? The motion is to advance 345 to E & R for review. Have you all voted? Have you all voted? You are voting on the advancement of 345. CLERK: 27 ayes, 9 nays on the motion to advance, Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion carried and the bill is advanced. If you have your worksheet before you, you move down to the next area and we have already moved LB 538 and LB 568 and so the next bill is LB 418. Mr. Clerk, what is the status of 418?

CLERK: (Read title to LB 418.) The bill was first read on January 17. It was referred to the Public Health and Welfare Committee. It was advanced to General File. There are committee amendments by Senator Cullan's committee.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Senator Cullan, do you wish to make a motion to adopt the committee amendments to LB 418?

SENATOR CULLAN: Mr. President, members of the Legislature, I move that the committee amendments to LB 418 be adopted. What the committee amendments do are strike provisions in LB 418 for expanding the advisory board for the mobile homes and the recreational vehicles group within the Department of Health. We felt it was unnecessary to go from seven members to nine members and we saw no reason to expand the board. We asked questions here in the public hearing
