SPEAKER MARVEL: Senator Fowler, the first... Senator DeCamp has asked unanimous consent to withdraw his amendment to the committee amendments but we have to deal with your amendment first. What is your pleasure? I have about three lights on here and I'm not sure how many wish to speak to your amendment.

SENATOR FOWLER: Senator DeCamp suggested that the committee amendment not be adopted?

SPEAKER MARVEL: Yes.

SENATOR FOWLER: The committee amendment that was so crucial ten minutes ago? Oh, okay. I guess I will withdraw my motion temporarily to send it back to committee. I do think if this interest rate increase was needed that there should have been an opportunity for the Banking Committee to get full testimony about that but if the committee no longer feels that, I will withdraw that motion.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Senator Fowler asks unanimous consent to withdraw his amendment. Is there an objection? If not, so ordered. The Chair recognizes Senator Lamb. Senator Lamb. Senator Kahle, do you wish to be recognized? Senator Warner, your light is still on. Do you wish to speak to this motion? Okay. Now the motion is withdrawn. Now, Senator DeCamp, do you withdraw your amendment to the committee amendments? Okay. Is there any objection to that? If not, so ordered. Now we are dealing with the committee amendments to the bill and the motion is to adopt the committee amendments. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote no. Have you all voted? Clerk, record the vote.

CLERK: 0 ayes, 21 nays on the adoption of the committee amendments, Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion lost and the committee amendments are not adopted. Now, Senator DeCamp, what do we do with the bill?

SENATOR DeCAMP: Move that the bill as unamended be advanced.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion is that 492 be advanced to E & R
