LB 183, 23

CLERK: Roll call vote taken. (See page 1172, Legislative Journal.) 25 ayes, 18 nays, Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Motion carried.

CLERK: I have nothing further on the bill, Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Senator Wesely.

SENATOR WESELY: I move for the advancement of LB 183 to E & R engrossment.

SPEAKER MARVEL: All those in favor of that motion say aye, opposed no. Motion carried. Bill is advanced. LB 52. Senator Fowler, do you have amendments to LB 52? What about LB 23? Are there E & R amendments to LB 23? Senator Wesely.

SENATOR WESELY: You might as well leave the microphone on. We are going to be going at it for awhile. I move the E & R amendment to LB 23.

SPEAKER MARVEL: All those in favor of the motion say aye, opposed no. Motion is carried. The E & R amendments are adopted. Are there other amendments, Pat?

CLERK: Senator, it was replaced so we have to advance it. Then I have a motion to return.

SENATOR WESELY: Okay, I move to advance LB 23 to E & R for engrossment.

SPEAKER MARVEL: All those in favor of the motion say aye, opposed no. Motion carried. The bill is advanced. The Clerk has an amendment on the desk.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Venditte moves to return LB 23 to Select File for specific amendment. The amendments, Mr. President, apparently I don't have them in the Journal.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Senator Venditte, do you wish to be recognized on the motion?

SENATOR VENDITTE: Yes, I do, Mr. President. Members of the Legislature, I did pass out earlier in the day a copy of the amendments that you now have before you and I guess I am going to try to address myself to a problem that I project I kind of foresee in a crystal ball relative to this particular piece of legislation relative to the now licensing of mopeds. I have talked to a number of the major motorcycle
