SENATOR KELLY: Yes, Mr. Speaker, a question of Senator Cullan for information regarding dollars.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Senator Cullan.

We talked of LB 204 funds, but it has not come up in this discussion, what is the amount of money we're appropriating in '79-'80 out of...for LB 204 funds? Do you have that information available?

SENATOR CULLAN: One point one million dollars, Senator Kelly, is the funds from LB 101.

SENATOR KELLY: So last year we appropriated one million
