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question is, would there be, let's say how are you going to tell the difference between state funds and federal funds in the Art Council, and because I'm sure that a good...well I know that a good part of it are federal funds? Would they be eligible, even though they would be distributed through the Council?

SENATOR MURPHY: I don't know that the Art Council has been engaging in this type of display work, Senator, like I say, it seems to me that most of the funds I see the Art Council spending are grants that are made to various university people and college people for summer projects in community art work, this sort of thing, but this is specifically my concern, Senator, I do not want...

SENATOR COPE: Well, I understand, but what I'm getting at, this might be, and I don't know, a new project for the Art Council using what could be federal funds and I would hate to tie it down to tightly and I agree with you from state funds, I wouldn't argue that point, but I would like to have it be eligible for federal funds possibly through the Arts Council, is my point.

SENATOR MURPHY: Well, I don't know if the Arts Council could segregate those funds or might not, Senator, but if it comes down to the wire, and it cannot be done, with the federal fund portion alone, then I guess I would say it should be barred, because I do not want to see this state getting into another project of this nature with, I would have to say a no holds barred concept of the state can get in and fund this with state funds. Now it's far too localized. It will be in far too few communities for the citizens statewide in this state to have to be taxed to support that kind of a project. Let's let it be an art project under the prescription set forth of grants...

SPEAKER MARVEL: One minute.

SENATOR MURPHY: ...donations and federal funds.

SENATOR COPE: I agree, only I do...I don't want to see the Nebraska Arts Council entirely weaned out of the proposition due to federal funds...not, state funds I agree, federal funds is where we disagree possibly.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Senator Fowler and then Senator Dworak. Senator Fowler.

SENATOR FOWLER: Well I guess I would raise some of the
