SENATOR WESELY: Mr. Speaker, I move the E & R amendments to LB 358.

SPEAKER MARVEL: All in favor of that motion say aye.
Opposed no. The motion carried. The amendments are adopted.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Brennan now moves to amend.
(Read Brennan amendment as found on Page 1283 of the Legislative Journal.)

SENATOR BRENNAN: Mr. President and members of the Legislature, we struck all of the amendments to the bill last week, but we neglected to strike one in the present law, and this addresses itself to that problem. I move that the amendment be adopted.

SPEAKER MARVEL: You've heard the motion to LB 358. All those in favor of the motion vote aye, opposed no. The motion is the Brennan amendment to LB 358. Have you all voted? Have you all voted on the amendment to 358? Mr. Clerk, do you have the amendment before you? Would you read it again, please?

CLERK: Mr. President, the amendment reads: (Read the Brennan amendment.)

SPEAKER MARVEL: Okay, record.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 0 nays on the adoption of Senator Brennan's amendment.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion is carried. What do we do with the bill? Senator Wesely.

SENATOR WESELY: Mr. Speaker, I move that LB 358 be advanced to E & R for Engrossment.

SPEAKER MARVEL: All those in favor say aye. Opposed no. The motion carried. LB 52.

CLERK: Mr. President, the E & R amendments to LB 52 were adopted by the body on March 27. I now have amendments printed by Senator Fowler that are found on Page 1060 of the Legislative Journal.
