CLERK: 26 ayes, 1 nay on the adoption of Senator Fowler's amendment.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion carried. The amendment's adopted. Now we have a kill motion on LB 52, which will lay over the bill for one day. You have to suspend the rules.

SENATOR DeCAMP: .....now, is that okay? Mr. President, I'd move that we suspend the rules and take up the kill motion today. The whole purpose of the rule is to protect the introducer so he isn't taken unawares. I kind of suspected it might happen, so I'm not taken unawares. So I'd be willing to suspend the rules, and Senator Chambers says it's okay by him.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion is to suspend the rules and take up the kill motion on LB 52. The Chair had hoped that we could get at least to some of the bills right under that, there are about ten or fifteen bills that might save some time if we can do it after the kill motion. Senator Chambers.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: I'll ask unanimous consent to withdraw that motion for now. I'll have another shot somewhere else along the way.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Do you want us to proceed to advance the bill? The motion is to advance LB 52 to E & R for Engrossment, as amended. Whose bill is this? Senator DeCamp...is that, okay. All those in favor of that motion vote aye, opposed vote no. We're voting on the motion to advance the bill. Have you all voted? The motion is to advance 52 to E & R for Engrossment. Have you all voted? Senator Fowler. I'm sorry, Senator DeCamp. Have you all voted? The motion is the advancement of LB 52 to E & R for Engrossment. Have you all voted? Two. I'll call for it once more and then I'm going to...have you all voted on the advancement of LB 52 to E & R for Engrossment?

SENATOR DeCAMP: ...Call of the House.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The question is, shall the House go under Call? All those in...clear the board, please. All those in favor of the House going under Call vote aye, opposed vote no. Record.

CLERK: 14 ayes, 0 nays to under Call, Mr. President.
