PRESIDENT: Well, Mr. Clerk, would you advise Senator Koch where his amendment is in the order.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Koch's amendment would follow Senator Keyes' in the normal routine. I did not understand Senator Koch's to be an amendment to the committee amendments. Senator Keyes, clearly on its face stated they were amendments to the committee amendments. Senator Koch's did not.

PRESIDENT: All right, Senator Koch, we did not understand yours to be amendments to the committee amendments. Does that answer your question? Senator Keyes, now you have closed? We will now, the procedure is that we will take up them up, #3, #4, #6 and #7, in that order and we will have an individual vote on each one of them. Does anyone care to hear the motions individually or just take them up? All right. The motion then is the adoption of the Keyes' amendment to the committee amendment of LB 285, Keyes' amendment #3. Amendment to the amendment, #3. All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Have you all voted? Record the vote.

CLERK: 2 ayes, 24 nays, Mr. President, on adoption of Keyes amendment #3.

PRESIDENT: The motion fails on #3. Proceed then with the vote on the Keyes amendment #4 to the committee amendments on LB 285. All in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Have you all voted? Record the vote.

CLERK: 4 ayes, 24 nays on adoption of Senator Keyes' amendment #4, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: Motion fails on #4. We will now proceed to Keyes' amendment #6 on to the committee amendments of LB 285. All those in favor of adopting amendment #6 vote aye, opposed nay. Have you all voted? Have you all voted? Record the vote.

CLERK: 19 ayes, 15 nays on adoption of Keyes' amendment #6, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: Motion carries. The Keyes' amendment #6 is adopted. Proceed then with the Keyes' amendment #7. All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Record the vote.

CLERK: 5 ayes, 23 nays on adoption of Keyes' amendment #7.
