SENATOR CARSTEN: Only if those divisions that receive funds year after year will it be included in there. If it is only a one year deal it is not but if they continue the next year, then that first year has to be taken into consideration.

SENATOR MARESH: So this would hamper water development in the future if we pass this bill? Correct?

SENATOR CARSTEN: If it is a continuing budget.

SENATOR MARESH: Well I think there is a need for more water development. That is what I am concerned about, that we do not prevent water development.

SENATOR CARSTEN: I have to remind you again, Senator Mares, that they do have the right to present the problem at a hearing and proposal to the people for their decision if that is necessary.

SENATOR MARESH: Thank you.

PRESIDENT: Okay, Senator Carsten, then that will conclude your closing remarks. Senator Carsten, do you have any further closing remarks then? The question then is the adoption of the committee amendments as amended on LB 285. All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Record the vote.

CLERK: 29 ayes, 1 nay, Mr. President, on the adoption of the committee amendments.

PRESIDENT: Motion carries. The committee amendments are adopted.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Carsten has amendments on page 836. I understand you wish to withdraw those.

SENATOR CARSTEN: Wish to withdraw those.

PRESIDENT: All right, they are withdrawn. Speaker Marvel, what do you wish to do with regard to the timing on the... It is seven minutes after twelve.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Are we ready to move the bill?

PRESIDENT: How many amendments do we have?

CLERK: Senator Koch, are you going to hold yours until Select, Senator? Then the last one I have, Senator, is from Senator DeCamp. I have one more.
