SENATOR KELLY: Senator George, I have an amendment to strike the new definition for mobile homes and reinsert the old definition that you desire and I will be giving that to the Clerk.

SENATOR NICHOL: Senator DeCamp, did you wish to finish?

SENATOR DeCAMP: Are there more speakers?

SENATOR NICHOL: The Speaker tells me that we have about one minute to go on this and we have six lights on.

SENATOR DeCAMP: Then I'd call the question.

SENATOR NICHOL: Do I see five hands? I do. Those in favor of ceasing debate please vote aye, those opposed no. Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Senator Nichol voting aye.

SENATOR NICHOL: Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 0 nays to cease debate, Mr. President.

SENATOR NICHOL: Senator Simon, if you will make this very short, I guess maybe we can vote on it.

SENATOR SIMON: Mr. President, I will try to make it pretty short. Mr. President and members of the body, the motion is to send the bill back to committee. Senator Kelly, I could have put a kill motion on the bill but that was not my intent. I honestly have a number of questions and I am trying to do this in a sincere and legitimate manner. If you would prefer to have the bill killed, I might be able to get the votes to do that but some of the questions that I have, fourteen days, how did they come up with that? Can the recreational manufacturers make those corrections? The fourteen days were decided by the Department of Health. What is meant by a defect in a recreational motor vehicle? Is it a scratch on a table, is it a blemish on a tire? Does it relate to the life of the product? Who determines the reasonableness in value of the product which it states in pages 22 and 23? The Department of Health. How much will it cost the state in developing a flat rate repair manual? What about penalties for other types of vehicles? For example, autos, TVs, household appliances. How much do all these rules and regulations cost the people of the State of Nebraska? I can go on and on. The point is that a number of issues have not been asked, a number of questions have
