CLERK: Mr. President, your committee on Miscellaneous Subjects whose Chairman is Senator Newell gives notice of public hearing in Room 2230.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Schmit moves to direct the Clerk to request the Governor to return LB 321 to the Legislature for further consideration.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The Chair recognizes Senator Schmit.

SENATOR SCHMIT: Mr. President, members of the Legislature, LB 321 was passed by this body several days ago. There are several words in the bill that cause a conflict with the intent of the committee and I request the bill be returned.

SPEAKER MARVEL: All those in favor of Senator Schmit's motion to return the bill from the Governor's office, what is the number, 321, vote aye, opposed vote no. We are seeking 25 votes of approval. Have you all voted? Record.
