SENATOR WESELY: No.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Okay. All those in favor of adoption of the Committee amendments vote aye, opposed no. Clerk, record the vote.

CLERK: 27 ayes, 0 nays on the adoption of the Committee amendments, Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion is carried and the amendments are adopted. The Clerk has an amendment on the desk.

CLERK: Yes, sir. Senator Warner moves to amend the Committee amendment by striking section 44 and renumbering sections 45 to 48 as 44 to 47.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Whose amendment is it?

CLERK: Senator Warner's.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Senator Warner.

SENATOR WARNER: Yes, Mr. President, as I indicated, that strikes section 44 which was the authorization for federal and cash fund match, hundred thousand each for the Armstrong Park related to the legislation that was enacted last session, but to date the arrangements between Mrs. Armstrong and the Game Commission have not worked out and she requested no funds be provided for this year.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion is the adoption of the Warner amendment to LB 542. All those in favor of that motion vote aye, opposed vote no. Have you all voted? We're voting on the Warner amendment to LB 542. Record.

CLERK: 28 ayes, 0 nays on the adoption of Senator Warner's amendment.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion is carried and the amendment is adopted, and now we will...if there is debate we will proceed on the motion to advance the bill. Senator Wesely, do you wish to speak on the bill?

SENATOR WESELY: Thank you. Mr. Speaker and members of the Legislature, I rise in support of the bill, but I also rise to make a point, because included in this bill is a section dealing with the deficit appropriation of about three million dollars for Medicaid payments, and I know that this probably isn't the time to raise the issue,
