SENATOR DUIS: Mr. President, if it would help those folks that are terribly distressed here, they could go ahead and I'll withdraw my amendments and let them advance it because there are some other people that have amendments for it and I'd sure hate to put these poor people that have these parking places in...

SPEAKER MARVEL: How many amendments do we have, Mr. Clerk? Do you want to withdraw your amendments?

SENATOR DUIS: Yes, I'll withdraw them because I sure don't want to be....

SPEAKER MARVEL: Is there any objection to the withdrawal of the Duis amendments? Do you object? Okay, it goes to the bottom of the...okay, Senator Newell, do you wish to...unless there is objection, Senator Newell will attempt to advance the bill. Senator Newell.

SENATOR NEWELL: Yes, Mr. President and members of the body, I'd like to advance the bill. I have shown, and the Committee has shown as much good faith. We've prepared amendments which almost take care of everybody's concern. I think we can put some amendments on. I will work with you if you have problems on this on Select File. I move the advancement of the bill.
