

recall, for the state to accept or reject the bids, and as this bill progresses across on toward Final Reading, if it is not necessary to increase the total appropriation, that is if there are certain items that can be stricken from the bid specs appropriately, why there is a possibility that that amount could be reduced but again that will be the later funding and will not affect this year's current budget. There is \$66,000 reappropriated for the Kearney, an athletic field at Kearney. The \$700,000 that is reappropriated for the construction of the Health and Physical Education Building at Peru which is under construction, there is \$674,000 for the HYPER building at UNO for its completion. There is \$20,000 reaffirmed and under construction for the renovation of the dredge Lewis by the Historical Society, Meriwether Lewis, as I recall, and also the construction of a steel frame to keep the vessel from rotting out. Included also are the annual payments for the Omaha State Office Building Educational Center level of \$960,000 per year, payment for the Lincoln State Office Building at the level of \$3,600,000 a year and the payment for the State Office Building at North Platte at the level of \$50,000 per year. There is \$100,000 reappropriated for the completion of the improvements made at the missile display near SAC headquarters. This is done through the Economic Development, and then the final item in the bill is the \$320,000 annual payment on the facility that is about to be constructed for the law enforcement training at Grand Island. The total amount of reappropriations in the bill is \$15,827,000. It would anticipate a continuation of \$16,300,000 for next year and \$9,600,000 for fiscal year 81-82. That are the items contained in the bill. Mr. President, I move its advancement.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Senator Goodrich, do you wish to be recognized?

SENATOR GOODRICH: Yes. Would Senator Warner yield to a couple of questions please? Senator Warner, could you turn to page 6 of LB 593. We are talking now about the Omaha medium-minimum facility, prison facility. Are you with us? Okay, you indicated \$1.2 million, roughly speaking, being added, right?

SENATOR WARNER: A \$1.6 million is added on the last year's, third year's appropriation to accommodate a vocational training facility in addition to what was previously provided...redesigned, yes.

SENATOR GOODRICH: Okay, what I want to know is when you talk about redesigned, could you elaborate and tell us what you have in mind?
