SENATOR GEORGE: Well, I hate to do that but I think I want to have a Call of the House.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Okay, clear the Board. The question is, shall the House go under Call? All those in favor vote aye, opposed no. Record.

CLERK: 12 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, to go under Call.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion is carried and the House is under Call. All legislators please take their seats. Unauthorized personnel leave the floor. Record your presence. Senator Schmit, Senator Johnson. Do we have four excused? Senator Dworak, Senator Haberman, Senator Goodrich, Senator Wagner, Senator Brennan, Senator Fitzgerald, Senator Chambers, Senator Venditte, Senator Kelly.

SENATOR GEORGE: Would the Clerk accept call ins now?

SPEAKER MARVEL: Are all legislators in their chairs? Can't accept call in votes until all legislators have taken their seats. The Clerk cannot accept call in votes until all legislators have taken their seats. Senator George, there are two absent. Do you want a roll call vote?

SENATOR GEORGE: Okay, that might be a shorter method of doing it.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Okay, the Clerk will call the roll.

CLERK: Roll call vote taken. (See pages 1386 and 1387, Legislative Journal.)

SENATOR GEORGE: I move to raise the Call.

SPEAKER MARVEL: There has been a request to raise the Call. Reluctantly the Chair raises the Call because we have about three more amendments that we need to gather the forces to make a decision.

CLERK: 14 ayes, 27 nays, Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Motion lost. Any other amendments?

CLERK: I have one now, Mr. President. Senator Newell moves to amend: Read Newell amendment as offered on page 1387, Legislative Journal.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The Chair recognizes Senator Newell.
