the bill is. I was contacted by the city's lobbyist and was told that there is a split on the bill and this information was given to me after the announcement was carried in Saturday's paper, that the number of council members has been reduced from twelve to nine, so I would ask that the bill be advanced and then before I do anything else with it, I would give you that copy so you can see what has been done on the bill. I will place other information in your hands relative to this bill and the issue of district elections in Omaha and see what the fate of the bill would be from that point but if anybody has any questions I would be more than anxious to answer them if there is time.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion is on the advancement of 329 as amended to E & R for review. All those in favor... Senator Wesely.

SENATOR WESELY: Is there any time left? Well, that's okay.

SPEAKER MARVEL: There is a couple of minutes. Do you have a question of Senator Chambers? The motion is to advance the bill to E & R for review. All those in favor vote aye, opposed no. We are advancing the bill to E & R for review. Have you all voted? We are voting on the advancement of LB 329 to E & R for review. Have you all voted? Have you all voted? The motion is the advancement of the bill, 329.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Mr. Chairman, I will ask for a Call of the House and not delay.

SPEAKER MARVEL: A Call of the House has been requested. All those in favor of placing the Legislature under Call vote aye, opposed no. Record.

CLERK: 7 ayes, 0 nays to go under Call, Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Motion carried. The House is under Call. All legislators please take their seats, record your presence. Unauthorized personnel please leave the floor...board. We are under Call. The issue before the House is the advancement of LB 329 to E & R for review. As long as legislators stay in their seats then we can take call in votes. We can't take them in right now. The Legislature is under Call. All legislators are to be in their seats. Senator Keyes, Senator Dworak, Senator Hoagland, Senator Maresh. Now all legislators in their seats, then we will take... May I repeat once more, all legislators are to be in their seats according to the regular rules.
