SENATOR NICHOL: They are going to go into an additional building on to the present facility.

SENATOR KEYES: Have they got possession of the buildings now?

SENATOR NICHOL: Yes.

SENATOR KEYES: You have the buildings, you want the money for the beds and you are giving away a portion of the property. Okay.

SENATOR NICHOL: The portion of the property that is being disposed of or perhaps will be disposed of is not quite a quarter of a mile away and as I stated they are not adaptable for bed patients. So, if this, if the VA should go ahead with their program they will build new buildings next to the building that is already there.

SENATOR KEYES: That is what I thought. They will build new buildings, and for \$500,000 worth of beds how much do you suppose the buildings are going to cost?

SENATOR NICHOL: From what I understood and these figures are several months old, approximately two and a half million.

SENATOR KEYES: Two and a half million, we will probably be coming in here next year after we get the beds bought and after we give away some more property. Someplace I would like to go out and walk over that ground with you and look and see where we are going to put the two million dollars and where we are going to put the beds. It seems funny to get the beds before we get the building.

SENATOR NICHOL: No, I'm not....

SPEAKER MARVEL: Senator Frank Lewis.

SENATOR LEWIS: I call for the previous question.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The question has been called for. Do I see five hands? I do. All those in favor of ceasing debate vote aye, opposed vote no. Voting on ceasing debate. Record.
