SENATOR NICHOL: Mr. Chairman, I move for the adoption of the amendment.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Is there further discussion on the adoption of the amendment? Senator Wesely do you wish to...I'm sorry. Okay, all those in favor of the Nichol amendment to LB 594 vote aye, opposed no. Have you all voted? Have you all voted? Senator Nichol, what is your pleasure.

SENATOR NICHOL: I move for a Call of the House and a roll call vote.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Okay, clear the board. The House is under Call. The legislators will please take their seats, record your presence, unauthorized personnel will please leave the floor. Record your presence. Lets vote to go under Call. All those in favor vote aye, it has been a long day. Record.

Can't have call in votes until everybody is in their seat, according to our rules, not mine, yours. Before we take call ins, the Chair recognizes Senator Newell for a statement.

SENATOR NEWELL: Mr. President, members of the body, I have.. I did not realize that this was coming up so I was unable to file a conflict of interest report. I do have a conflict and so on this issue in regards to my employment, for that reason I will be abstaining.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Thank you. The Clerk can now accept call ins.

CLERK: Senator Hasebroock changing from no to yes. Senator Labeled voting aye. Senator Landis changing from no to yes. Senator Goodrich voting aye. Senator Wagner voting aye. Senator Keyes voting aye.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Okay, record. Announce the vote.

CLERK: 27 ayes, 4 nays on the adoption of the amendment.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Motion is carried, amendment is adopted. Do you have another amendment? The Call is raised. Do you have another amendment?
