CLERK: Yes, sir, I do. Senator Warner now moves to amend the bill, Mr. President. Read Warner amendment. Amendment appears on page 1446 of the Legislative Journal.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Chair recognizes Senator Warner.

SENATOR WARNER: Mr. President and members of the Legislature, and members of the committee, I forgot to, I didn't think of this until this morning. What this amendment does is it took out \$10,000 cash fund authorization for the Armstrong Park and we took it out and discussed it in committee as far as the deficiency bill is concerned. Frankly I forgot there was also an amount in here and it was her wish to have that money not identified as an appropriation at this point at least. This merely reflects the removal of that authorization. It has no impact one way or the other as far as the appropriation bill cause it is out of the NORDA fund and I assume that the authorization here either won't be spend or could be used for some of the other projects because they are somewhat at an estimate level for some of the programs.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Any further discussion? Senator Newell, your light is on, do you wish to....The motion is to adopt the Warner amendment to LB 594. All those in favor vote aye, those opposed vote no. Record.

CLERK: 27 ayes, no nays, Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Motion is carried, amendment is adopted.

CLERK: I have nothing further on the bill, Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Senator Warner.

SENATOR WARNER: Move the bill be advanced, Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Motion is the advancement of 594 to E & R for review. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote no. Motion is the advancement of the bill. Have you all voted? The Chair has already voted, can't break the tie. Have you all voted? Senator Warner, what is your pleasure?

SENATOR WARNER: Can I ask first, is there some people absent or not here that are not excused, I should ask? It indicates eight not voting, otherwise I would ask for a roll call vote.

SPEAKER MARVEL: There are four excused.
