SPEAKER MARVEL PRESIDING

SPEAKER MARVEL: Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Quorum present, Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Senator Nichol, are you ready to take up the committee amendments?

SENATOR NICHOL: Mr. Chairman, members of the Legislature, I am not very ready since I haven't had a chance to fill in all of the amendments' figures as proposed by Senator Lewis. Perhaps, Senator Lewis, you could help me here briefly and as soon as we get that worked out I guess we are ready to go since it is merely a matter of... thank you, Senator Stoney, of substituting the figures that Senator Frank Lewis has offered as opposed to the proposed amounts. I would suggest, Frank Lewis, that you watch as I go along to see if this is correct as presented to me by Senator Stoney. The Supreme Court salary as proposed by the committee was \$44,500 and your amendment was \$53,000. Is that correct? Then the District Court was \$42,000 to \$45,000 plus the supplement. Is that correct? And then the Juvenile Court was \$41,000 and that has been raised to \$42,500 plus the supplement. Then Workmen's Comp has been raised from \$39,000 to \$42,500. The County Court in Sarpy, Douglas and Lancaster would be \$38,500 plus the supplement and all the other County Courts' judges in the state from \$37,000, to \$37,000, which would remain the same. Then in the Municipal Court it would be raised from \$38,000 to \$40,000. Is that all correct as amended by your amendments, Senator Lewis?

SENATOR LEWIS: That is correct.

SENATOR NICHOL: All right. Mr. Chairman, I would suggest that these are the proposals as they now stand as amended by Senator Lewis' amendment to the amendments.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Let me ask you one question. You were reading first of all, from a mimeographed sheet.

SENATOR NICHOL: That is correct.

SPEAKER MARVEL: And are these same figures in the Journal on page 1069 and also 1453?

SENATOR NICHOL: I believe that is the page. Just a second.
