SPEAKER MARVEL: All in favor of the adoption of the amendments say aye, opposed no. Motion carried. The amendment is adopted.

SENATOR NEWELL: Mr. President, members of the body, I rise to explain some things about the Duis amendments, hoping that Senator Duis will get up here...here he comes. Just a little preparation while Senator Duis is coming up. We have worked out those things, Senator Duis, and they are the next amendments up after yours.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The Chair recognizes Senator Duis on the amendments to LB 348.

SENATOR DUIS: What I need to do is ask Senator Newell, are my amendments contained in yours?

SENATOR NEWELL: Yes, they are.

SENATOR DUIS: Then it would be best and proper for me to withdraw this amendment?

SENATOR NEWELL: Yes. Actually they are Fowler's amendments. I offer...but he is carrying the amendments.

SENATOR DUIS: If that is the case then, I would ask for unanimous consent to withdraw my amendment.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Any objection? So ordered.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Fowler now moves to amend LB 348. Would you like me to read it, Senator? Is that necessary?
