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guidelines and to close some loopholes there but not to have a complete review of doctors offices. Transfer of facilities is another major issue that we'd be happy to discuss. I think at this point in time I will let whoever else speaks next. I will be happy to answer any questions that do come up.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Senator Schmit.

SENATOR SCHMIT: Mr. President and members of the Legislature, Mr. Speaker, is it permissible for me to offer an amendment to the committee amendments at this time?

SPEAKER MARVEL: Senator Cullan was speaking to the committee amendments.

SENATOR SCHMIT: Yes, and I would like to offer....

SPEAKER MARVEL: And you have an amendment to the committee amendments.

SENATOR SCHMIT: I have an amendment to the committee amendments on the Clerk's desk which I would like to offer.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Is it an amendment to one of these that Senator Cullan has been referring to?

SENATOR SCHMIT: It is an amendment to the entire committee amendments, Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Senator Goodrich, for what purpose do you arise?

SENATOR GOODRICH: Mr. President and Senator Schmit, rather, we really haven't even finished presenting the committee amendments first of all, but number two, I am going to ask can you hold off the amendments to the committee amendments until we get done with the committee amendments and then take a vote on that, find out which form of the bill we are going to be amending, whether it be the green form or the white form? That is what we need to know and we need to know which one you are going to be amending.

SENATOR SCHMIT: Mr. President.

SENATOR GOODRICH: At least we ought to finish the committee amendments.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Let me, Senator Schmit, do you want to make a comment or shall....I was going to ask him a question. Go ahead.
