Senator Reutzel. We've got about four absent, Senator Newell. Do you want to proceed?

SENATOR NEWELL: Please.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Okay.

CLERK: Senator Beutler...

SPEAKER MARVEL: We are voting first of all...let's review what we're going. We're voting on the second Chambers amendment to the Committee amendments to LB 152. Okay, call the roll.

CLERK: (Roll call vote taken which may be found on Page 1561 of the Legislative Journal.) 13 ayes, 24 nays, Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion lost. The amendment is not adopted. The motion is that the call be raised. The call is raised. Before we proceed to the next order of business, in the north balcony it's my privilege first of all from Senator Hasebroock and Senator George's districts to recognize twenty-five ladies, the Home Extension Club from Cuming County. The Home Extension Agent is Deborah Lee who is a former Page, Legislative Page. Where are you up in the north balcony? Will you raise your hands so we can... yes. Where is Deborah Lee? Where's Deborah? There you are. Okay. Welcome.
