

think if you read page 7 or 8 it is largely self explanatory. There is really no need to go into a lot of detail. In terms of the second provision it starts on page 8 and runs into page 9 all we are talking about is that we are requiring the lobbyist to do the same thing that we have to do as candidates. That is keep the underlying records so that any kind of audit that is conducted can be done completely and fairly. The commission's auditing powers are not going to be worth much if the underlying records are not kept in the offices so that they can really take a hard look at what is happening. Now the other provision simply details certain kinds of disclosure requirements made of certain categories of public officials. The lobby expenditures on those public officials have to be broken down into five categories, campaign contributions, food and drink, other things that are set out on the bottom of page 7. These are really ordinary kinds of disclosure requirements that many, many states around the country require. It is not going to impose any additional hardship on the lobbyist by any means. This is the sort of stuff they keep track of anyway as far as I know, and I think that it will just tighten up our bill a little bit and it is a good proposal. Thank you, Mr. Speaker.
