SENATOR GEORGE: Call for the question.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The question has been called for. All those in favor of ceasing debate vote aye, those opposed vote no. Question is shall debate cease. Have you all voted? Record.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 10 nays to cease debate.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Motion carries, debate ceases. Senator Lamb, do you wish to close on your amendment? The motion is the adoption of the Lamb amendment to LB 99. All those in favor vote aye, those opposed vote no. Have you all voted? Have you all voted? Have you all voted? Record vote has been requested. The Clerk will read the record.

CLERK: Record vote read. 17 ayes, 23 nays, 7 present and not voting, 2 excused and not voting. Vote appears on page 1628 of the Legislative Journal.

CLERK: We have to adopt the committee amendments, Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Senator Reutzel.

SENATOR REUTZEL: Move we adopt the committee amendments, Mr. Speaker.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion is the adoption of the committee amendments. Senator Hefner.

SENATOR HEFNER: Mr. Chairman, members of the body I would like to ask the Clerk, what are the committee amendments now? Did we adopt any amendments to the committee amendments? Just the Murphy amendment?

CLERK: Senator Murphy offered two amendments which were adopted.

SENATOR HEFNER: We adopted both of them?

CLERK: Yes sir.

SENATOR HEFNER: Okay. I would just like to talk a little bit about the committee amendments. I am a member of the Constitutional Revision Committee and you can see by the report from the committee that I voted against it. I feel that we have too many commissions now in state government. I
