SENATORS: It is closed, it is closed.

SPEAKER MARVEL: I'm sorry, you are right, you are correct, excuse me. The vote is on the Merz amendment to LB 99. All those in favor vote aye, those opposed vote no. SENATOR NICHOL: Now we are back on the committee amendments and the Chair recognizes Senator Reutzel.

SENATOR REUTZEL: There are no further amendments?

SENATOR NICHOL: There are no further amendments, Mr. Clerk?

SENATOR REUTZEL: Then very simply I would move the adoption of the committee amendments.

SENATOR NICHOL: There are no other lights on so the question is, we are voting on the committee amendments. All those in favor vote aye, those opposed vote nay. Record, Mr. Clerk.

SENATOR NICHOL: You are voting on the advancement of LB 99 from General File. Have you all voted? Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 7 nays on the motion to advance, Mr. President.
