SENATOR SIMON: Yes, I had it there, then on page 12, line 15 it provides for a definition, it seems to me at least upon first blush that those definitions are a little bit incongruous, would you care to elaborate on that.

SENATOR SIMON: Both of them have that, John. I'm just saying that the definitions and I don't....
