SPEAKER MARVEL: Senator Koch, there are three absent. Senator Kennedy, Senator Clark, Senator Brennan. Three excused absences.

SENATOR KOCH: In that case, Mr. Speaker, I'd ask for a Call of the House and record vote...roll call vote, I'm sorry. Well, if they call in I'll take them.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Okay, a Call of the House has been requested. All those in favor of placing the House under Call vote aye, opposed vote no. Have you all voted? We're voting on a Call of the House. Clerk, record the vote.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 0 nays to go under Call, Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The House is under Call. All legislators please take your seats. Record your presence. Unauthorized personnel please leave the floor. As soon as all legislators are in their seats, the Clerk will be authorized to take in...accept calls. We can't accept them yet until everybody is in their seats. Let's see, Senator Burrows, Senator Landis, Senator Koch, Senator Cope, Senator Keyes, Senator Wesely, Senator Beutler, Senator Maresh, Senator Dworak, Senator Cullan, Senator Wagner, Senator Chambers, Senator Frank Lewis, Senator Clark...no Senator Clark's excused, Senator Reutzel. Do you want to proceed with the roll call vote now, Senator Koch? Yes. Senator Lewis has requested a roll call vote. Are you ready for the roll call vote, Senator Lewis? Okay, Clerk call the roll.

CLERK: (roll call vote taken as found on Page 1661 of the Legislative Journal.) 23 ayes, 17 nays, Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion lost.

CLERK: Mr. President, if I'm...Senator Koch had amendments printed in the Journal on Page 1417 and 1290 and I understand he wants to withdraw those.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Senator Koch.

SENATOR KOCH:those.

CLERK: Pardon me.

SENATOR KOCH: Is that the one we just did?

CLERK: Those...as I understand it the one we just did was a combination of these two that you had printed previously.
