

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion carried. The House is under Call. All legislators please return to their seats. Record your presence. Unauthorized personnel please leave the floor. We still have the same group...Beth, do we have three absent? Senator Murphy, Senator Burrows, Senator Koch, Senator Warner, Senator Cope, Senator Schmit, Senator Rumery, Senator Buetler, Senator Lamb, Senator Maresh, Senator Kremer, Senator Merz, Senator Fitzgerald, Senator Newell, Senator Hoagland. Three unaccounted for, Senator Johnson. Three absent and three unaccounted for...two unaccounted for. Are all legislators in their seats? Okay. Are there any...does anybody wish to call in a vote?

CLERK: Senator Newell voting aye. Senator Cullan voting aye. Senator Kremer voting aye. Senator Duis voting aye. Senator Fitzgerald voting aye. Senator Stoney voting aye. Senator Dworak voting aye. Senator Haberman voting aye. Senator Wagner voting aye.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Okay, record the vote.

CLERK: Senator Kelly voting aye. 26 ayes, 6 nays, Mr. President on the adoption of Senator Johnson's amendment.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion is amended and the resolution... or the amendment is adopted. The Clerk tells me there are upwards of ten amendments left, so we've got a lot of work ahead of us. What's the next amendment?

CLERK: Mr. President, the next amendment is offered by Senator Schmit, but that's the one that I think he wants to withdraw, but I'm not sure.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The Chair recognizes Senator Schmit.

CLERK: Senator, this is your amendment that's found on Page 1440 that we discussed.

SENATOR SCHMIT: This is the amendment that repeals the provisions of LB 1?

CLERK: Yes, sir.

SENATOR SCHMIT: Mr. President and members of the Legislature, I'd just like to say that I believe the bill is going to be in such a condition that it's not going to be acceptable to anyone, but I think everyone ought to have their try at it and until that time comes and they have concluded they have no...nothing left, why I'll just let them have
