LB 355

SPEAKER MARVEL: Senator Clark, are you ready on 355?
Senator Cullan, do you want to pass over 259 temporarily?

SENATOR CULLAN: Yes, Mr. President, we do.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Okay.

CLERK: (Read title to LB 355.) The bill was read on January 16 of this year. It was referred to the Public Health Committee. The bill was advanced to General File. There are committee amendments to LB 355 by Senator Cullan's Public Health Committee.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The Chair enthusiastically recognizes Senator Clark.

SENATOR CLARK: Thank you, Mr. President. I really appreciate that. You are not going to let Senator Lewis take over. Are you?

SPEAKER MARVEL: No.

SENATOR CLARK: Well, thank you.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Senator Cullan, do you have committee amendments to 355?

SENATOR CULLAN: Mr. President, I guess that is what the Clerk told me. It has been so long. The committee statement says that the committee amendment to the bill is to delete unnecessary reference to the plural of physical therapist, to delete redundant provisions and to make the bill intentionally consistent. In all honesty I can't remember the committee amendments but let's hope the committee statement is correct. Move for the adoption of the committee amendments.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion is the adoption of the committee amendments to LB 355. All those in favor of that motion vote aye, opposed no. We are adopting the committee amendments as explained by Senator Cullan to LB 355. Have you all voted? We are voting on the committee amendments to LB 355.

SENATOR CULLAN: Mr. President, I move for the Call of the House.
