SPEAKER MARVEL: All right, now we are speaking to the Simon amendment #1 which is on page 1573. Senator Labeledz.

SENATOR LABEDZ: Thank you, Mr. Speaker. I would address my remarks to Senator Simon because I believe, Senator Simon, your two amendments were amendments to Senator DeCamp's amendment. He has withdrawn those. He just did.

SENATOR SIMON: No, they can be used without Senator DeCamp's amendments.

SENATOR LABEDZ: What I wanted to say, that the same two amendments that Senator Simon has is included in the amendment that I have coming up next. They are identical.

SENATOR SIMON: Senator Labeledz, that is not correct. The second one is. The first one is not. It is not. The first one is not.

SENATOR LABEDZ: Okay, well, we will vote on it.

SENATOR SIMON: The second one is word for word. You copied my amendment but the first one is not the same.

SENATOR LABEDZ: But according to the Journal, yours is an amendment to the amendment so I just wanted to make sure that the wording was right for an amendment to the bill.

SENATOR SIMON: I am offering this as an amendment to the bill. Thank you.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Does anybody else wish to speak on the Simon amendment #1? Okay, the motion before the House is the adoption of the Simon amendment #1 to LB 382 as found on page 1573. Senator Simon, do you have any other comments? All those in favor of the motion vote aye, opposed no. Have you all voted? Senator Simon.

SENATOR SIMON: Mr. President, I know that we do have about fifteen or sixteen people that are not in the Chamber but I kind of hoped that we had enough people here that would vote, but if we are going to have to prolong it, I guess that I will reluctantly.....

SPEAKER MARVEL: Have you all voted? Have you all voted. Record the vote.
