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about two million dollars in the same period in bank accounts in Mexico and who knows where else and I think it is wrong for us to be a part of that fraud and I think if you look very closely at the information you can see it is a fraud. And I will point out just one additional thing on this issue. The laetrile proponents have several theories.

SPEAKER MARVEL: You have one minute.

SENATOR CULLAN: And when the medical community picked apart one theory, the cyanide theory, proved that that was useless, then they went to the vitamin theory because they want to keep one step ahead of everybody. Well, the vitamin theory isn't selling me and it is not selling the medical community when they just simply label a drug Vitamin B 17 because it isn't a vitamin. The Committee on Nomenclature of the American Institute on Nutrition, the National Nutrition Consortium, the American Dietetic Association, the American Society for Clinical Nutrition and I have a list of professional organizations don't even recognize a vitamin larger than B 12 but here is Vitamin B 17.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Thirty seconds.

SENATOR CULLAN: Quackery, that is what it is and if you vote for this bill you are assisting quackery in the State of Nebraska. I feel strongly about it. We should kill this horrible piece of legislation.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Senator Vickers, you haven't spoken. Your light is on. Do you wish to speak? We are on the motion to kill.

SENATOR VICKERS: Thank you, Mr. Speaker, and fellow doctors, I for one don't have a doctors degree but I have sat here all morning and I have heard elected officials trying to outguess the medical profession, it seems to me. This bill, as I read it as it has been amended and has been mentioned this morning, is a permissive piece of legislation. I will submit to you that if it is so permissive then why do we even need it. As Senator Cullan says, there is nothing in the law that says you can't use it now. I don't know why we need a piece of legislation that just simply says you may use it. I don't think we are doing anything. I think we have been spinning our wheels here all morning. I think the real doctors out there are still going to make their own decision whether they want to give it or not give it and that certainly is not my decision and I don't think it should be any of the other members of the Legislature's de-
