SPEAKER MARVEL: Senator Newell...

SENATOR NEWELL: Yes, let's do a real quick roll call.

SPEAKER MARVEL: A roll call is requested. Clerk call the roll. All legislators will be in their seats. All legislators will be in their seats. Okay, call the roll.

CLERK: (Took roll call vote as found on Page 1783.)

SPEAKER MARVEL: We've got to have enough order in the House so that the Clerk can hear the votes.

CLERK: (Continued roll call vote.) 19 ayes, 21 nays Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion lost. The Call is raised. Don't go too far. What's the next amendment?

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Lewis moves to amend.

SENATOR LEWIS: Well, Mr. President, this amendment simply asks the Regents to enforce the bill we passed on 70 year olds still working, but everybody knows me, I know when I've lost and the Regents are in control, so I ask unanimous consent to withdraw my amendment.
