SENATOR MURPHY: Mr. Chairman, I am assuming we are on Select File and each of these amendments will require 25 votes in the affirmative.

SPEAKER MARVEL: That is true. That is true. At least we agree on that. The motion that I have posed before that I will pose once again, if you vote yes you vote to strike Section 27. If you vote no you vote against striking 27. All those in favor of the motion vote aye, opposed no. Have you all voted? Senator Lewis.

SENATOR LEWIS: This is Senator Haberman's motion.

SPEAKER MARVEL: If there is no objection, the Clerk is going to record the vote.

CLERK: 16 ayes, 21 nays, Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Motion failed. Clerk, read the next motion which would be what, Section 35?

CLERK: Section 35, yes, sir.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Okay.

CLERK: Mr. President, Section 35 reads as follows: Program 905. The Board of Regents of the University of Nebraska is hereby authorized to renovate the Agricultural Engineering Building at the Lincoln campus with a total project cost not to exceed \$2,894,000 which amount includes \$138,000 planning funds previously appropriated. There is hereby appropriated \$1,100,000 from the State Building Fund for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1980, to initiate the renovation. There is hereby appropriated \$1,656,000 from the State Building Fund for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1981, to complete renovation of the Agricultural Engineering Building.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Okay, the motion before the House is the striking of Section 35 of LB 594 on page 15. Senator Haberman, this is your amendment. Do you have any comments in closing?

SENATOR HABERMAN: As I understand it we have to move to adopt my amendment and then go separate one by one. Is that correct?
