SENATOR HABERMAN: I was under the impression we adopted Senator Lewis' amendment and then we went one by one.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Yes, that is where I parted company with the group. We are now considering, on page 15 of 594, the striking of Section 35. Do you have any comments?

SENATOR HABERMAN: Yes, I do. I withdraw my amendment, Mr. Chairman, and I submit a new amendment.

SPEAKER MARVEL: You are out of order. We are considering amendments...the Lewis amendment to the amendment has been adopted. You are in no position to withdraw your amendment.

SENATOR HABERMAN: They are my amendments, Mr. Chairman. Can I amend my amendment?

SPEAKER MARVEL: Yes, you can amend your amendment.

SENATOR HABERMAN: I withdraw my amendments, Mr. Chairman.

SPEAKER MARVEL: You can't withdraw your amendments. They have been amended.

SENATOR HABERMAN: Under what rule, Mr. Chairman?

SPEAKER MARVEL: Your recourse, Senator Haberman, is to vote against the motion. We are in the midst of voting. You can't stop the voting but you can vote against the motion. Okay, the motion at the moment is the proposition which would strike Section 35 of LB 594 on page 15. All those, now remember if you vote aye you are voting to strike. If you vote no you are voting against striking. All those in favor of the motion vote aye, opposed vote no to Section 35. Have you all voted? Have you all voted? Senator Haberman, I am going to call the vote. Is that all right with you? Okay. Record the vote.

CLERK: 16 ayes, 23 nays, Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Motion lost. Now we have a third section and the Clerk will once more read the section.

CLERK: Mr. President, the following new language would be added to the bill: Program 999. The Board of Regents of the University of Nebraska is hereby authorized to install a chiller at the Lincoln East Campus with a total project cost not to exceed \$1,645,000. There is hereby appropriated \$1,100,000 from the State Building Fund for the
