SENATOR KOCH: This bill is on behalf of the State of Nebraska and the communities that we oftentimes speak so nobly of.

SENATOR LEWIS: I just saw the Chamber of Commerce out there and I thought they were interested in it. Do they have an interest?

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion is the adoption of the Kelly amendment as presented, I am sorry, Murphy amendment, the first Murphy amendment of the morning. All those in favor vote aye, opposed no. We are voting on the first Murphy amendment. Have you all voted? We are going to need 25 votes on each one of these amendments. If you are in favor of the amendment, the Chair would appreciate having you indicate so. Senator Koch is under a time bind. Have you all voted on the first Murphy amendment to LB 158? Record.
