SENATOR KEYES: Yes, can you give me the names of the ones that are excused?

SPEAKER MARVEL: Senator Haberman, Senator Merz, Senator Fowler, Senator Goodrich, Senator Venditte and we are still looking for...let's see.

CLERK: Roll call continued. 20 ayes, 21 nays, Mr. President.
