CLERK: I have nothing further on the bill.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Okay, do you want to move the advancement of the bill, Senator Brennan?

SENATOR BRENNAN: I so move.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion is the advancement of 467 to E & R for Engrossment. All....a machine vote has been requested. All in favor vote aye, opposed no. Have you all voted? The motion is to advance the bill to E & R for Engrossment. Have you all voted? Have you all voted? Senator Brennan.

SENATOR BRENNAN: I hate to do it, but I'll ask for a roll call vote. Call of the House.

CLERK: 15 ayes, 1 nay to go under Call, Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The House is under Call. All legislators please take your seats. Record your presence. Senator Landis, Senator Warner, Senator George, Senator Keyes, Senator Cullan, will you...you have. Senator Vickers, Senator Simon, Senator Chambers. Senator Chambers, Senator George and Senator Landis. Senator George, Senator Landis. Do you want to go ahead with a roll call vote? Everybody is here but Senator Landis.

SENATOR BRENNAN: Call the roll, please.

CLERK: (Roll call vote taken which may be found on Pages 1930 and 1931 of the Legislative Journal.) 22 ayes, 10 nays, Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion lost. The bill is not advanced. Now we have 37....how long is 378 going to take? We've got an exhausted Legislature. I think I'd like to Senator Nichol and Senator Hoagland after the session. We're not going to be able to process that amendment now. We can do it tomorrow. Is there any objection to doing it tomorrow? As soon as the session is over, would you two please come up so we can visit with you? Now will you proceed on the replaced bills, Mr. Clerk?
