SPEAKER MARVEL: Okay, the motion is the return of the bill to Select File for the Fitzgerald amendment to 152. All those in favor of returning the bill vote aye, opposed no. Have you all voted? Record.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 1 nay on the motion to return, Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion is carried. The bill is returned. Senator Fitzgerald, do you want to move the adoption of your amendment?

SENATOR FITZGERALD: Move the adoption of the amendment.

SPEAKER MARVEL: All those in favor of adopting the Fitzgerald amendment to 152 vote aye, opposed no. Have you all voted? Record.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 0 nays on adoption of Senator Fitzgerald's amendment.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The amendment is adopted. Senator Wesely, do you want to move the bill?

SENATOR WESELY: I move LB 152 be readvanced to E & R for engrossment.

SPEAKER MARVEL: All in favor of that motion say aye, opposed no. Motion is carried. The bill is readvanced. Now we move to the DeCamp amendments.

SENATOR DeCAMP: I have said everything. Move it be returned.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion is the adoption of the DeCamp... to bring the bill back from E & R for engrossment to adopt the DeCamp amendments to 152. Senator DeCamp, do you have any comments? Senator Chambers.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Senator DeCamp, because of time constraints I won't debate the bill at this point but Senator Hoagland has some concerns and what he is trying to figure out is how he can get the bill held a day so he can look at the amendment that you are offering, so that is what his question is and I don't have any debate but I told him I would ask how that can be accomplished based on what you are trying to do.
