SENATOR LEWIS: Mr. Speaker, I would leave that to your good judgement but I would suspect that probably we won't know very much until Friday or Monday, but I am not going to make that a specific question. The question I have today is, let's not read it today.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Well the Chair interprets that to mean only today then. The motion is to lay the 365 over one day. All those in favor vote aye, opposed not. Excuse me? A record vote has been requested. Have you all voted? Senator Lewis.

SENATOR LEWIS: Mr. President, this was an important enough issue that it is going to be one of the best of the session. We might as well get right at it. I ask for a Call of the House. We are under Call?

SPEAKER MARVEL: We are under Call.

SENATOR LEWIS: Then I don't make that request, Mr. President. I would ask for a roll call vote.

SPEAKER MARVEL: A roll call vote has been requested. The Clerk will call the roll.

CLERK: (Read roll call vote found on page 1986 of the Legislative Journal.) 24 ayes, 18 nays, Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Motion lost. Is there any other motions on the desk?

CLERK: Yes, Mr. President. Senator Simon moves to return LB 365 to Select File for a specific amendment, that amendment being to indefinitely postpone.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The Chair recognizes Senator Simon. Excuse me, the House is under Call.
