SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion is the return of the bill to Select File is the first motion. All those in favor of returning LB 398 to Select File vote aye, opposed vote no. 25 votes. Record the vote.

CLERK: 27 ayes, 3 nays on the motion to return, Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Motion carried. The bill is returned. Now, Senator Dworak, do you want to move the adoption of your amendment?

SENATOR DWORAK: Mr. President, I move the adoption of my amendment.

SPEAKER MARVEL: All in favor of adopting the amendment vote aye, opposed no. Have you all voted? Have you all voted? Record.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 9 nays on the adoption of Senator Dworak's amendment.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Motion carried. The amendment is adopted. Senator Wesely, do you want to move the bill? Excuse me. Okay, the motion is to advance the bill to E & R for engrossment. A machine vote has been requested. Senator Nichol, your light is on. Okay, all those in favor of returning the bill to E & R for engrossment vote aye, opposed no. Have you all voted? Record.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 17 nays on the motion to return, Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The bill is returned. The next motion is by Senator Nichol. The Chair recognizes Senator Nichol.

SENATOR NICHOL: Mr. Chairman.

SPEAKER MARVEL: You have a motion up here.

SENATOR NICHOL: Yes, I want the one I put up last first.

CLERK: Okay, Mr. President, Senator Nichol moves to return LB 398 to Select File for specific amendment. The amendment being to strike all the amendments adopted to LB 398 except
