SPEAKER MARVEL: The vote is on the Beutler amendment to LB 357. All those in favor of the Beutler amendment vote aye, those opposed vote no. Have you all voted? Voting on the Beutler amendment to LB 357. Have you all voted? Senator Beutler.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Mr. Speaker, I would like to have, I assume the House is not under Call.

SPEAKER MARVEL: You want the House under Call?

SENATOR BEUTLER: Yes, Mr. Speaker. I would like a call of the House and a roll call vote.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Okay, the question before the House is, shall the House go under Call? All those in favor of placing the House under Call vote aye. Record.

CLERK: 13 ayes, 2 nays to go under Call, Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The House is under Call. All legislators please take your seats. Record your presence so that we can proceed with the roll call vote as rapidly as possible. Senator Murphy, Senator Burrows, Senator Koch, Senator Warner, Senator Keyes, Senator Schmit, Senator Johnson, Senator DeCamp, Senator Cullan, Senator Haberman, Senator Brennan, Senator Vickers, Senator Chambers, Senator Kelly, Senator Venditte, Senator Labeledz. All those who have not recorded their presence please do so. Senator Murphy, yes, you are here. Two absent Senator Beutler, Senator Venditte and Kelly. Do you want to proceed with the roll call? All right, call the roll.

CLERK: Roll call vote. 15 ayes, 25 nays Mr. President. Vote appears on pages 2041-2042 of the Legislative Journal.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Motion lost.

CLERK: I have nothing further on the bill, Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Senator Schmit, Senator Kahle.
