SPEAKER MARVEL: All in favor of that motion say aye, opposed no. Motion carried. The bill is advanced. The next bill is LB 162. Senator Newell.

CLERK: Mr. President, there are E & R amendments to LB 162.

SENATOR WESELY: I move the E & R amendments to LB 162.

SPEAKER MARVEL: All in favor of that motion say aye, opposed no. Motion carried. The E & R amendments are adopted.

CLERK: Mr. President, I now have amendments offered by Senator DeCamp.

SPEAKER MARVEL: To LB 162?

CLERK: Yes, sir, I do.

SENATOR DeCAMP: I really should try to adopt these amendments but I am going to withdraw them for this year.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Hearing no objection, so ordered.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Newell moves to add the emergency clause to LB 162.

SENATOR NEWELL: Mr. President, members of the body, LB 162 does make some changes. It basically takes some of the more difficult provisions of the sunset provision out and numerous people have come and asked me to put this emergency clause on because they feel that it will improve the law considerably and for that reason I ask that we add the emergency clause.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Is there any other discussion on that motion? Motion is to add the emergency clause to LB 162. All those in favor of that motion vote aye, opposed no. We are voting on the adoption of the emergency clause to LB 162. Have you all voted? Clerk, record the vote.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 2 nays, Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Senator Newell. Motion is adopted. Did you have another amendment?

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Hoagland has an amendment pending but I understand he wishes to withdraw.
