Now I have worked, my staff have worked and others have worked very dilligently to try to fashion a compromise and we have in fact fashioned that compromise, one that I have heard no obvious oppose and one in which the commission which has to enforce the law is not opposed to, and I am happy as heck, that's an euphemism for what I wanted to say, that we have got some basic agreement, that we have a workable bill at this point. Now I really think we have done a tremendous job and that is why I don't want anybody opposing this bill. It should go through.

Senator Cope. Senator George, no, Senator George is excused. Senator Keyes, Senator Schmit, Senator Lamb, Senator DeCamp, Senator Cullan, Senator Chambers, Senator Kelly. Senator Keyes, we need your green button. We are under Call. Senator DeCamp. Senator Chambers and DeCamp and the Clerk is authorized to take call in votes. The motion is the advancement of LB 162 to E & R for engrossment.
