still don't have it done. I am just telling you it won't work to have a youngster take these courses at UNO and then go out there and transfer his courses out there to get an associate degree. It just won't work. It is between two different school systems, higher education systems. The courses are being given right now. It does not cost a nickel to hand the youngster a piece of paper at the end of two years, say okay, here is your associate degree, now you can get some consideration at least for the game warden's position. That is why I am doing it. It doesn't cost anything. It just makes it more reasonable, logical and a lot more convenient for the people of the east end of the State of Nebraska to be able to have their youngsters considered for the programs. Thank you. I ask you to return the bill so that we can adopt the amendment.

PRESIDENT: The question before the house then is, the return of LB 141 for the Goodrich specific amendment. All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Have you all voted? Everybody is supposed to be at his or her desk. This is on Final Reading. Record the vote.

CLERK: 17 ayes, 25 nays, Mr. President, on the motion to return.

PRESIDENT: Motion fails. Yes, proceed then, Mr. Clerk. Let's make sure everybody is...just a moment...make sure that all members are at their desks. We are going to proceed to read LB 141 on Final Reading. Would all members please return to their desks so we may proceed? Thank you. Yes, we are on Final Reading. All right, Mr. Clerk, we will proceed then on Final Reading on LB 141.

CLERK: (Read LB 141 on Final Reading.)

PRESIDENT: All provisions of law relating to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall LB 141 pass. All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Have you all voted? Record the vote.

CLERK: (Read record vote as found on pages 2091-2092 of the Legislative Journal.) 33 ayes, 11 nays, 4 excused and not voting and 1 present and not voting, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: LB 141 passes on Final Reading.
