PRESIDENT: The motion carries. The DeCamp amendment is adopted. The Chair recognizes Senator Wesely.

SENATOR WESELY: Mr. Speaker, I move that LB 42 be readvanced to E & R for Engrossment.

PRESIDENT: The motion is to advance LB 42 to E & R for Engrossment. Any discussion? All those in favor signify by saying aye, opposed nay. LB 42 is readvanced to E & R for Engrossment.
