question for Senator Warner, but I believe in his discussion with Senator Keyes he has answered one of my questions. I wanted to be sure that the intent of the Legislature was shown this morning as we discussed this bill that these monies generated by the extra or the one cent gasoline tax we're talking about would not be tied up but they could be used and would be available for highway maintenance and construction. I think that Senator Warner in discussing with Senator Keyes has established that certainty. So I have no question with Senator Warner, but I wanted to be sure that the intent was shown as we discussed this bill that that money would not be tied up indefinitely to await the need for it in the way of guaranteeing the bonds related to the construction of a gasohol plant, and I think we have established that, so I support the amendment.

PRESIDENT: All right, Senator Warner, you may close and I think, however, at this point before we vote on this motion, Senator Keyes made a point that I think is well taken and that is these people that are up and jumping and running around, and I do concur with that, Senator Keyes, that they are to be at their desks, including you right now. Would all members of the Legislature be at their desks because we're going to just hold up now on this vote until we make sure everybody is at their desk because the House is under Call. Sergeant at Arms, see to it that everyone that's been wandering around out there is back here. Senator Newell, you're here, yes. Senator Reutzel is here. Senator Newell is here. I think everyone is here now. Senator Warner, you have waived your closing, so the question before the House is the adoption of the Warner amendment on LB 571. All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Record the vote.

CLERK: 38 ayes, 1 nay, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: The motion carries. The Warner amendment is adopted, and Senator Wesely....

SENATOR WESELY: Mr. Speaker, I move that LB 571 be advanced to E & R for Engrossment.

PRESIDENT: Senator Cullan, you asked for a board vote. Senator Cullan does ask for a board vote on this. All those in favor of advancing LB 571 to E & R for Engrossment vote aye, opposed nay. Record the vote.

CLERK: 30 ayes, 4 nays on the motion to return, Mr. President.
