PRESIDENT:if Senator Marvel has been doing that that's fine, if that's the way you want to do it. But I have not been doing it. Okay. Senator Newell, did you wish to speak to the motion?

SENATOR NEWELL: Mr. President, I'd like to call for the question in hopes of expediting this issue.

PRESIDENT: All right, his light was on, so the question has been called for. There is no need to call for it, because you're the only light that's on, so the question... Senator Hoagland, do you have any close? The question before the House is the adoption of the Hoagland amendment. All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Have you all voted? Have you all voted? Well, Senator Hoagland, I guess you'll have to.....record the vote, and we have a request for a record vote on this too by Senator Venditte.

CLERK: (Record vote was taken which may be found on Pages 2209 and 2210 of the Legislative Journal.) 26 ayes, 14 nays, and 9 not voting, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: The motion carries. The amendment is adopted. Senator Wesely, would you wish to return the....Senator Wesely. Return LB 378.

SENATOR WESELY: Mr. Speaker, I move that LB 378 be advanced to E & R for Engrossment.
